The ICES files of German bottle and CTD data have been assigned Accession Number 9800177. The files have been copied and unzipped in /usr/nodc/DATAIN/9800177. In that directory, the file 9800177.txt includes a brief abstract of the data set, and a summary of the number of stations per ship. There are a total of 54,496 stations collected by 56 ships from 1920 - 1989. The file geo.gif shows the geographic distribution of stations. File date.dist shows the number of stations per decade.
