Hi Doug,

We have been receiving their data in annual increments and are reasonably up to date. The fastest sampling interval is hourly in the JASL (NODC) archive. We have metadata on the stations listed. Basically they have a series for each side, and on each side, the station has moved location but has been geodetically linked to the same benchmarks to keep a continuous time series. I have all the metadata. If you want to archive the 15 minute data too, I can forward metadata.

Just got back from England. Had some excellent weather, got up to 86 deg one day.
