Line P data is collected typically 3 times each year, in late winter, spring and late summer. Fisheries and Oceans Canada vessels and personnel collect data at a series of 27 stations along Line P. Usually, 5 of these stations are sampled for oxygen and nutrients. Other special studies are carried out by PIs and graduate students (primary productivity, TCO₂/Alk, DMS, iron distribution, POC/N, sedimentation of particulate materials to deep ocean, etc).
