SUMMARY

The R/V Ocean Veritas has departed Port Fourchon after conducting crew change and vessel maintenance.



1. VESSEL OPERATIONS

1.1 Daily Operations

The R/V Ocean Veritas has completed crew change. Regular safety watches are underway and the vessel crew continues to prep and paint the vessel for departure. The deck was secured and the vessel prepared for departure.

1.2 Science

Winkler Titration techs on board and Titration process trainers set up equipment and train techs. Fugro crew change and handover was completed. Checked and tested CTD and Niskin bottles. A science team meeting was conducted.

1.3 Safety

Job Safety Analysis was conducted as needed for onshore operations as well as an oil spill drill. A regular, daily safety meeting was held with the vessel crew; a safety meeting with the science team was held with extra stress on staying hydrated due to the very high heat index.

1.4 Engineering

The engineering team onboard the R/V Ocean Veritas conducted scheduled preventive maintenance as per ISM and PMP and regular engine room checks.
