
DATA MANAGEMENT: Please be advised that not only does the [FOARAM Act](#) call for a data and information exchange, but that the Executive Office of the President Office of Science and Technology Policy released a [memorandum](#) on February 22, 2013 stating the administration's commitment to increase access to federally funded published research and digital scientific data. To better meet these requirements, the OAP will be enforcing a policy whereby continued project funding will be contingent on all PIs closely coordinating their data submission plans with NODC. NODC is tasked with overseeing data management and archival of all OAP funded data. While it is not required that all data and metadata comport to [NODC guidelines](#) before engaging with NODC, it is required that engagement with NODC on a data submission strategy for your project be conducted. THE RESPONSES TO THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THIS PROGRESS REPORT AND IS A PREREQUISITE TO RECEIVE FINAL FY14 FUNDING ALLOCATIONS:
